2. What does Antigone beg the people of Thebes to bear witness to? (lines 681-689)
3. Who does Antigone blame for her terrible misfortune? (lines 695-700)
4. What does Creon sarcastically say would have man singing forever? (lines 708-709)

Inference Questions:

1. Antigone mentions the curse on her father. Why is it appropriate for her to allude to it at this point in the play?
2. Why is Antigone bothered by some of the responses of the chorus before her death? (lines 700-708) Support with text evidence.
